Key Numbering Components

- Equipment Category Code – Two-letter code identifying the type of equipment:
 - TB – Terminal/Junction Box
 - SL – Streetlight
 - FL – Floodlight
 - LA – General lighting
 - LE – Emergency light
 - LS – Light switch
- Unit Number – Two-digit number (00-99) assigned to each unit within a plant or building .
- Voltage Number – Two-digit code representing voltage level:
 - 01 – 115 kV and above
 - 10 – 34.5 kV
 - 20 – 13.8 kV secondary voltage
- Serial Number – Two-digit number starting at 01 for each piece of equipment in a category .
