Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR)

A Visual Fault Locator emits a visible red laser into the fiber. If the fiber is broken or damaged, the red light leaks out at the fault point, allowing technicians to quickly identify breaks, bends, or poor connections. VFLs are ideal for quick troubleshooting and continuity checks .

Optical Power Meter and Light Source

The optical power meter measures the optical power received at the end of a fiber, while a light source injects a stable signal at specific wavelengths (e.g., 850 nm, 1310 nm, 1550 nm). Together, they are used for insertion loss testing, link loss measurement, and verifying signal integrity. This method is highly accurate for assessing attenuation across fiber links .
