Color Coding for Fiber Identification

Fiber optic cables use color codes to distinguish individual fibers within a cable. The TIA-598-C standard defines a 12-color sequence for fibers: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua. For high-count cables (more than 12 fibers), a “Tube and Fiber” system is used, where the 12-color sequence is applied to both the outer buffer tube and the fibers inside it. For example, Fiber #34 in a 48-fiber cable would be the Violet fiber in the Green tube . Single-mode fibers are typically yellow, while multimode fibers are orange or aqua .

Connector and Termination Types

Fiber terminations are achieved through connectors or splices. Connectors create temporary joints or connect fibers to network equipment, while splices form permanent joints. Connectors usually have a ceramic ferrule to align fibers and are compatible with various securing mechanisms like bayonet, screw-on, or snap-in adapters. Proper termination ensures low insertion loss and minimal reflectance, which is critical for maintaining signal quality .
