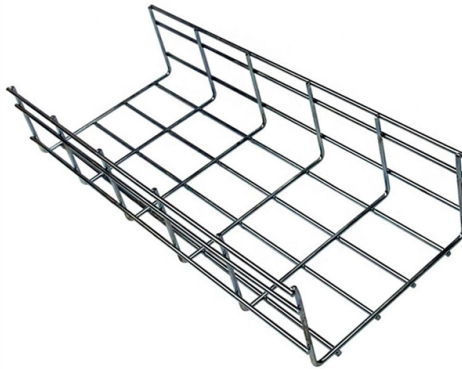

- Connector Insertion
 - Insert the prepared fiber into the connector plug, ensuring precise alignment with the ferrule.
