This box is not intended for direct connection to household appliances; instead, it acts as a central hub for controlling and protecting the electrical supply.

- Isolation switches: Allow safe disconnection of the incoming power for maintenance or emergencies.
- Circuit breakers: Protect the system from overloads and short circuits.
- Leakage protectors (RCCBs): Detect current leakage to prevent electric shocks.
- Busbars: Copper bars that distribute electricity evenly to outgoing circuits.
- Measuring systems: Monitor voltage, current, and other electrical parameters for safety and efficiency.
