 - Figure 8 Cable: Named for its strength member forming a figure-8 shape; types include GYTC8S, GYXTC8Y, and GYXTC8S, offering high mechanical strength, water resistance, and UV protection ().
 - OPGW (Optical Ground Wire): All-metal cable used on power lines, combining data transmission with lightning protection ().
