Saw Cutting and Chiseling

For cast-in-place boxes, grooves can be created after the concrete has cured using concrete saws or chisels. This method is suitable for creating channels for pipe inlets, outlets, or overflow connections. The groove depth and width should match the pipe diameter or the intended joint sealant thickness. Care must be taken to avoid cracking the surrounding concrete, and edges should be smoothed to prevent stress concentrations .
