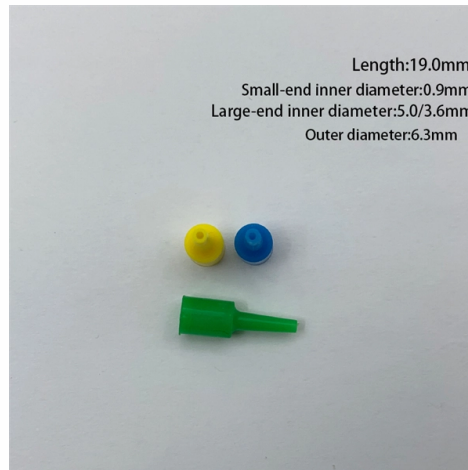

- **Grounding and Bonding:** Metal boxes must be properly grounded and bonded to maintain electrical continuity and safety .
- **Neat Cable Management:** Wires should be routed cleanly, secured, and insulated to prevent damage or accidental contact .
