- **Cable Organization:** ODFs arrange incoming and outgoing fiber cables systematically, preventing tangling and maintaining proper bend radius ().
- **Splicing and Patching:** They facilitate fiber splicing (joining fibers) and patching (rerouting signals) for network flexibility ().
- **Protection:** ODFs shield fiber terminations and connectors from mechanical stress, dust, and environmental hazards ().
- **High-Density Management:** Designed for environments with dozens to hundreds of fibers, ODFs optimize space and allow easy access for maintenance ().
