

Residential Main Distribution Box Incoming Line

Incoming Line Overview

The incoming line is the point where electrical power from the utility enters your home. For a typical residential setup, this includes:

- Live wires (Hot/Line): Usually black or red, carrying the current from the utility. In a 120/240V split-phase system, there are two hot wires (Hot 1 and Hot 2) that are 180° out of phase, providing 240V between them and 120V to neutral for standard circuits .
- Neutral wire: Typically white or blue, connected to the neutral busbar inside the panel. It completes the circuit for 120V loads .
- Ground wire: Green or bare copper, connected to the grounding busbar and ultimately to grounding electrodes like rods or a UFER system .

Connection to the Main Panel

- Meter to Main Breaker: The incoming line enters the electric meter box, connecting to the L1/L2 incoming terminals for live wires and the N terminal for neutral. The meter measures total electricity consumption .
