

ST interface optical transceiver

The ST interface on an optical transceiver is the port where a fiber optic cable with an ST connector is inserted, typically featuring a 2.5mm ferrule and a bayonet-style locking mechanism.

Location and Identification

The ST interface is located on the front face of the optical transceiver module, which is the side that faces outward when the transceiver is installed in a switch, router, or other network device . It is designed to accept an ST (Straight Tip) fiber optic connector, which has a cylindrical shape and a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism for secure attachment . The connector can only be inserted in the correct orientation due to its keyed design, ensuring proper fiber alignment and signal transmission .

Connector Design

- **Ferrule Diameter:** The ST connector uses a 2.5mm ceramic or reinforced ferrule to house the fiber, providing precise alignment for minimal signal loss .
- **Coupling Mechanism:** The bayonet-style lock allows the connector to be twisted into place, securing it firmly and preventing accidental disconnections .
- **Compatibility:** ST interfaces support both single-mode and multimode fibers, making them versatile for LANs, telecommunication networks, and industrial applications .

Usage Tips

- Ensure the transceiver is powered down or the port is administratively disabled before connecting or disconnecting the ST fiber to avoid signal disruption .
