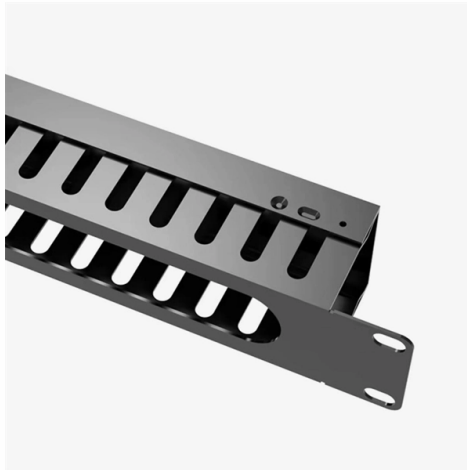


Using a Layer 3 Switch for Access
