

Vertical Cable Tray Wire Fixing Method

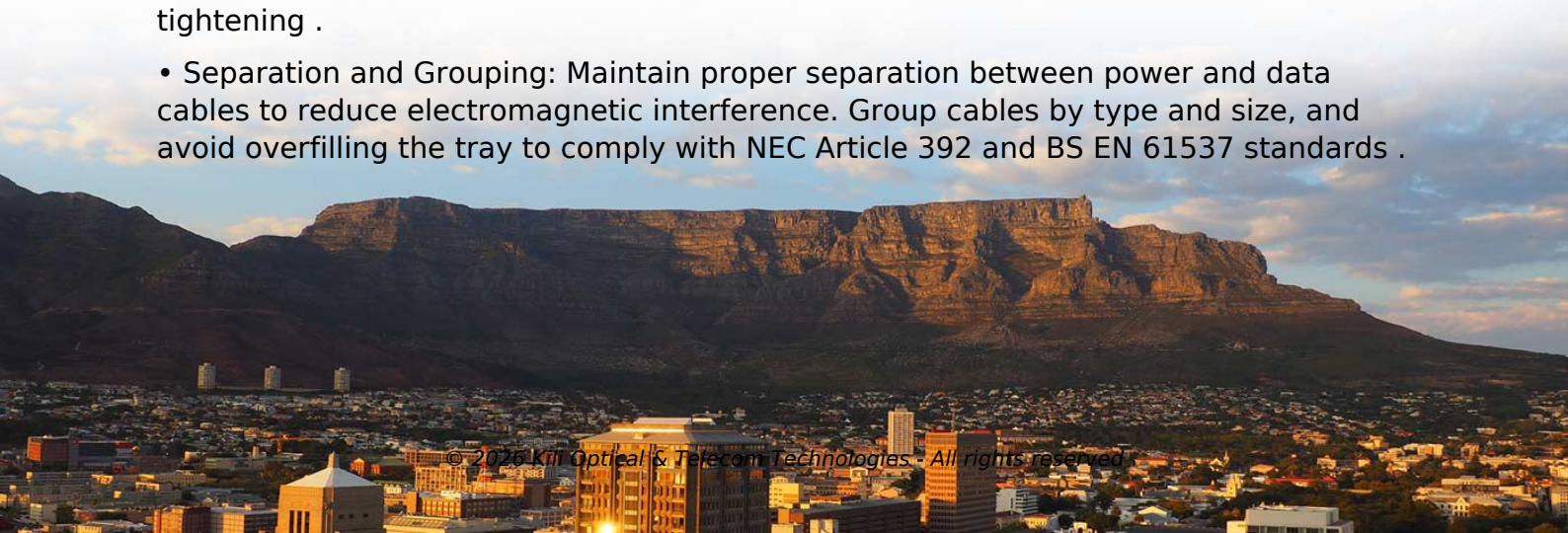
Vertical cable trays require secure attachment using wall brackets or cantilever supports, with cables tied using approved fasteners to maintain spacing, prevent sag, and comply with standards.

Selecting the Right Tray and Support

For vertical installations, ladder-type or ventilated cable trays are commonly used because their rungs provide convenient anchor points for securing cables and allow proper ventilation to prevent overheating . The tray must be supported using cantilever wall brackets or vertical support brackets attached directly to the wall or structural frame. The spacing of these supports should follow the manufacturer's load capacity charts to ensure mechanical integrity and prevent tray deformation .

Cable Fixing Techniques

- **Cable Ties and Straps:** Use UV-resistant or fire-rated cable ties to secure cables to the tray rungs. Ties should be applied at regular intervals to maintain cable alignment and prevent sagging .
- **Lacing or Hook-and-Loop Straps:** For sensitive instrumentation or control cables, lacing cords or hook-and-loop straps can be used to avoid damage from over-tightening .
- **Separation and Grouping:** Maintain proper separation between power and data cables to reduce electromagnetic interference. Group cables by type and size, and avoid overfilling the tray to comply with NEC Article 392 and BS EN 61537 standards .
