Mounting and Preparation

Use appropriate anchors for the substrate and, if vibration is expected, install isolation pads to protect wiring and terminal torque .

Cable Entry and Strain Relief

Plan cable entry points in advance. Use modular gland plates or cable glands to maintain ingress protection and provide mechanical strain relief, preventing conductors from being pulled at terminals during service . Avoid compressing grommets during tightening and ensure all entries are sealed according to the IP rating of the enclosure.

Internal Wiring Layout

- Arrange devices logically: Place heavier hardware lower to improve the center of gravity and reduce stress on fasteners .
